高崎商科大学 About Takasaki University of Commerce

Takasaki University of Commerce, a university for social sciences, commerce, marketing and accounting was developed in 1906. Its parent institution, an all-girls high school, was established by Tane Sato. Since then, Takasaki University of Commerce has enjoyed a vibrant 112-year history.

In conjunction with the affiliated junior college, TUC is a small university with the capacity for approximately 1,000 students. Our students can benefit from a rich student support system and a fully outfitted learning environment. With the founding principle of "autonomy and independence," the university focuses on practical learning and offers a wide range of subjects such as commerce, economics, and business administration.

Takasaki University of Commerce—an incorporated educational institution—is composed of a university, a graduate school, a junior college, a high school and a kindergarten. The total number of students studying at the incorporated educational corporation is roughly 2,300.

Department of Business Administration

This department has three courses, the Business Administration Course, the Information Course and the Tourism and Community Development Course. Students regularly acquire theories and practices from a business perspective through the study of business administration, commerce and economics. In particular, a characteristic feature of the course is the development of classes and extra-curricular programs in collaboration with companies. A significant emphasis is placed on the acquisition of a socially acceptable mindset and way of thinking.

In the Business Administration course, students learn about management strategies and humanistic management, including corporate social responsibility. In the Information Course, case studies are conducted using information networks and security as well as ICT. In the Tourism and Community Development Course, field work is primarily conducted in and around the local area. Students learn about tourism resources and regional development within this theme.

会計学科 Department of Accounting

In the Department of Accounting, some of our instructors are certified public accountants. Students engage in practical work with accounting professionals. The Accounting Department has two courses, the Accounting Course and the Finance Course. The Accounting Course aims to nurture experts in the fields of bookkeeping, finance, and taxation. The Finance Course fosters the study of funds procurement and operations with the aim of employment in financial institutions and securities companies. Students who want to learn a higher level of accounting can take advantage of our extracurricular programs provided by the Accounting Institute and can also aim for the challenging Certified Public Accountant Examination (CPA examination).











日本•群馬 About Gunma,Japan

Gunma prefecture is located in the northwest corner of the Kanto region—the central part of Japan. It is an area of immense natural beauty, completely surrounded by mountains. Although landlocked, heavy snowfall in the northern part of the prefecture makes Gunma a popular destination for skiers with its many ski lodges and resorts. Gunma is also well known among tourists for its hot springs and beautiful mountain scenery year-round. Along with its natural wonders, Gunma and the Takasaki area are home to many historic sites and cityscapes of historic value. In fact, the Tomioka Silk Mill in neighboring Tomioka was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2015.

The city of Takasaki—the home of the university—is conveniently located in the southern part of Gunma prefecture, only about 100 km from Tokyo or a 50-min journey by bullet train. Because Takasaki is so close to Tokyo, the local dialect is standard Japanese, which makes it the perfect location to learn and practice standard Japanese.

The Takasaki University of Commerce offers a course called "Japanese Conversation" as an extracurricular course. In this course, students enhance their proficiency in the Japanese language and gradually learn specialized disciplines such as economics, management, and accounting in Japanese. As these seminars mainly consist of research, discussion, and presentation, they offer diverse opportunities for learning Japanese in an innovative and communicative way.

Takasaki University of Commerce shares its campus with the Takasaki University of Commerce Junior College. Students of both institutions are actively encouraged to exchange various activities and events such as club activities and the student council are conducted in concert. The Takasaki University of Commerce strives to nurture "certified public accountants" and "certified tax accountants" who are experts in bookkeeping and accounting. The university collaborates with current certified public accountants to provide thorough and professional guidance for students.

As students can attend classes conducted by our professional faculty directly on campus, commuting time and cost is greatly reduced, creating a significant advantage.

As this program is aimed at enabling students to pass examinations ranging from the Bookkeeping Certificate Examination to the Tax Accountant Examination, this curriculum ensures that our students are ready and fully able to enter the job market upon graduation. Graduates of our programs are employed as certified tax accountants, as certified public accountants, in other fields related to accounting, as well as education. To enable study at various levels and help beginners learn with confidence, multiple study models and techniques are available. Study models can be chosen according to the aspirations of the students and the qualifications they are aiming for. Takasaki University of Commerce also offers a special teacher-training program for those aspiring to become educators and a Master's Degree program for students who wish to pursue further study and research after graduation.

The Takasaki University of Commerce campus is conveniently located a mere 10-min train ride from Takasaki Station or 15-min by car. Takasaki is a major station, with rail service by bullet train and other Japan Railway lines as well as the Joshin Dentetsu line. The area in and around the station is bustling with department stores, supermarkets, clothing stores and bookstores, ensuring easy access to all necessary amenities. There are also many food shops and restaurants in and around the station. The Takasaki area is relatively affordable compared with near-by Tokyo. The average rent for an apartment near the campus is between 30,000 and 40,000 yen: almost half that in Tokyo. And yet, the heart of downtown Tokyo is less than an hour away.

Dining out can be costly and cooking takes time, so the student cafeteria of Takasaki University of Commerce offers a nutritious, affordable breakfast on weekdays from 8:30 to 9:30, and several choices of delicious, affordable lunch on weekdays from 11:30 to 14:00.

Takasaki, the largest city in Gunma, boasts fresh air, mountains, rivers, wildlife, a rich, green landscape, and fewer occurrences of earthquakes at a fraction of the cost of Tokyo. Our students can enjoy the best of a country life all year long in a very habitable environment, with the capitol of Tokyo always nearby for those seeking a big city adventure.
